# Provincial PoET Training Program for Long-Term Care Homes— Cohort 2

We are pleased to announce the second cohort of the Provincial PoET Training Program beginning in September 2019

The award-winning PoET (Prevention of Error based Transfers) Project was created by Osler's Ethics Quality Improvement Lab. PoET helps to reduce consent-related errors in order to ensure that any treatment long-term care residents receive is both wanted and beneficial.

PoET has been developing over the last seven years, and is now successfully launched in more than half of the long-term care homes in the Central West LHIN, where there has been a decrease of 63% in repeat end-of-life transfers.
