PoET is an award-winning accreditation leading practice ethics quality improvement project that reduces consent related errors.

The PoET Southwest Spread Project (PSSP) is **launching in long-term care homes in the MHLHIN and HNHBLHIN** until March 2022.

The PSSP is a joint venture between William Osler Health System's Ethics Quality Improvement Lab and McMaster University's Department of Family Medicine and is supported by \$1.5 million from Health Canada's Health Care Policy Contribution Program.

Participating **LTC homes will be supported by both the Implementation and Evaluation teams for a year.**

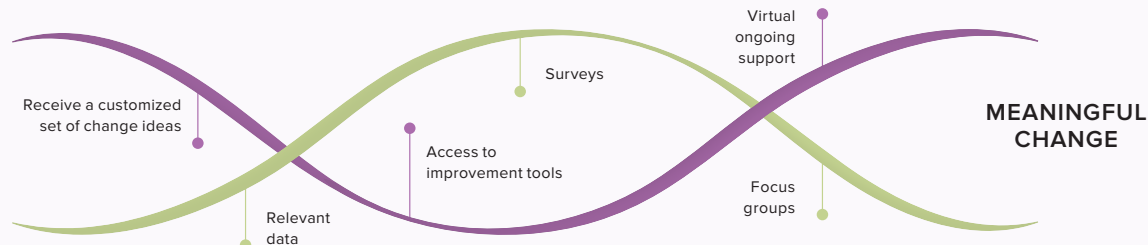
